### **What Jim did for the Marshall family (and won't let them forget it)**

### **What Shelly did for Jim**

- 2) Furnished residences (paying all expenses--upkeep, insurances, utilities, household items)
- 3) Took 2 days off work to drive Jim to airport to get to his folks
- 4) Picked Jim up in Kalispell (and delayed own work for over a week to take him to Nevada)
- 5) Brought Jim's items down the Alaska Highway and paid from her personal account because Jim said he didn't want to pay for it from their joint account since it was her business trip anyway
- 6) worked in NV for 2 days to get his property and things in shape (limbing trees, picking up garbage, packed his personal items in boxes and secured them, running errands--)
- 7) did weeks of research and foot work for investments that would benefit Jim and Shelly (including researching insurances, setting up contacts and appointments, getting bids for problems with properties, meeting with real estate people and looking at properties--bringing info back to Jim for discussion) countless hours spent
- 8) spent 4 hours on phone trying to fix his computer (failed but did get the warranty registered which Jim hadn't done)
- 9) arranged for management and insurance of his rental and made sure all details were addressed

- 10) kept books for investments, bank, for tax purposes--including mileage
- 11) intervened when Chris laid Jim off and asked Chris to rehire Jim so Jim could get another month's work
- 12) Birthday gift of cards of Jim on bike with Pockets: note he did not give a birthday gift to Shelly—told her there weren't any stores where he could shop for her
- 13) took pictures and built a web site so Jim could sell his property in NV. (took several days of work)
- 14) Placed ads on the internet for both his personal items and property so he could sell them
